

# VISITING WILDERNESS WOOD

Wilderness Wood is a family-owned woodland which hosts a growing number of small environmental, craft and educational enterprises. We welcome **the general public** to walk in the woodland and use the play areas during café-opening hours (Wednesdays to Sundays 9am-5pm and everyday in the school holidays). In exchange, we ask visitors to 'pay as you feel' for each visit in the box in the café to help us cover the costs of keeping the woodland open to the public eg. insurance, maintenance of paths and play structures, fencing and signage.

**Members of Wilderness Wood** can walk for free in the wood in daylight hours every day except during weddings or when requested not to by the owners.

## CODE OF CONDUCT:

- ACT AS A GOOD WOODSMAN AND 'LEAVE THE WOODS AS YOU FIND THEM OR BETTER'
- TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY
- RESPECT NO ENTRANCE SIGNS AND FENCING WITHIN THE SITE OR ON NEIGHBOURING LAND
- KEEP DOGS UNDER CONTROL, PARTICULARLY NEAR CHILDREN AND SHEEP
- TAKE ALL LITTER AWAY AND EITHER FLICK DOG POO OFF THE PATH AND INTO THE WOODS OR TAKE BAGGED DOG POO AWAY WITH YOU
- KEEP OFF WOOD STACKS AND AWAY FROM MACHINERY AND WORK AREAS
