

Wilderness Wood Members' Code of Conduct - May 2014

Wilderness Wood is a family-run woodland and a not-for-profit community and educational resource. The owners welcome members to walk and picnic in the woodland freely, except for one day a year - 22nd April.

In return we ask the following from members:

- to act as a good woodsman and 'leave the woods as you find them or better'
- to take responsibility for your own safety
- to respect no entrance signs within the site or on neighbouring land
- to keep dogs under control, particularly when school groups or children's parties are in progress
- to take all litter home
- to contribute to the stewardship and improvement of the woodland and its activities, for example:
 - volunteer for a day of a Working Weekend, held on the first weekend of each month, to do outdoor jobs such as clearing brambles, maintaining paths, planting trees
 - lead a workshop or give a talk in the cafe
 - help with the administrative work related to the running of the woodland
